### **Pétanque: You don't have a long way to go... Baar park**

For many of us, the word 'pétanque' may have an association of a lazy afternoon in a French park, where elegant gentlemen, smoking a cigar or pipe, are just gathering for a match. If you thought you would not have much fun, you would be completely mistaken. Pétanque has grown in popularity in recent years.

Pétanque is a game played by two teams of one to three players striving to throw hollow metal balls as close as possible to a small wooden ball called cochonnet, or jack. The game is very simple in principle, nevertheless, to master the technique and strategy you need to practise regularly. The big advantage is that this game can be played by anyone, from men and women to old men and children. So do not hesitate to go playing pétanque to Baar Park, where a pétanque course can be found. You say you don't have your own pétanque balls? **No problem, you can borrow them at the reception of the administrative wing of Building FILADELFIE.**



### **Reconstruction of Michelská Street – April**

The February edition of eReview detailed the reconstruction of Michelská and Budějovická streets. To remind you, we are providing you with the latest update to the schedule of the work on Michelská Street in April. To download the maps of temporary diversions click [here](#)

**On 3 April**, construction works will begin in the sector of Prostřední – Ohradní. The sector between Prostřední and Ohradní streets will be closed for traffic. The diversion for city transport buses and vehicular traffic will be set up along Ohradní and Baarova streets (from the centre) and Pekárenská and Ohradní streets (towards the centre). The other diversions towards Nusle – Kačerov (Na Jezerce, Sdružení, Budějovická, Vyskočilova, Michelská) and towards Vršovice – Krč (Chodovská, and along Jižní spojka/South Connecting Road until Vídeňská). Only one-way traffic will be allowed in Jemnická Street, however in the opposite direction than usual.

#### **Budějovická under Repair**

From 3 April to 3 August 2011, Budějovická Street will be under reconstruction, traffic will be only in one lane (1+1 system). The diversion will be from Kačerov along Sdružení Street, to the right to 5. května Street (from the centre), to the left to Vyskočilova and then in the direction of Kačerov. In the opposite direction, from Vyskočilova Street to the right to 5. května, to the right to Na Strži, to the right to Na Pankráci, to the right to Hvězdova and straight along to Sdružení. A diversion along Na Strži and Olbrachtova streets will be signposted for drivers who will arrive up to Budějovická."
