Reconstruction Is in Store for Michelská streets - May




To remind you, we are providing you with the latest update to the schedule of the work on Michelská Street in May. To download the maps of temporary diversions click [here](#)

On 1 May, construction works will begin in the sector of Ohradní – U Plynárny. The sector between Prostřední and U Plynárny streets will be closed for traffic.

For capacity reasons, it is proposed to use articulated buses, line No. 205, taking the same route, with a link to the regular service at the junction of Michelská and Vyskočilova. The diversion for No. 106, 24, 182 buses is set up along Nuselská, Na Jezerce, Hvězdova, Budějovická and Vyskočilova streets; No. 150 and 139 buses will go from Krč along Na Záhonech, Sliachská, Severozápadní I, Chodovská, Bohdalecká streets. The diversions for cars and lorries: Pekárenská Ohradní – Baarova, the direction of Nusle – Kačerov (Na Jezerce, Sdružení, Budějovická, Vyskočilova, Michelská) and the direction of Vršovice – Krč (Chodovská, along Jižní spojka/South Connecting Road until Videňská). "As Na Jezerce street will be very busy, we also propose traffic adjustments at the junction of Na Jezerce and Nuselská streets: from Na Jezerce Street right only to Nuselská Street, where there will be two lanes. While one of them, on the tram track, will be for the direction straight ahead, the other will be for vehicles going down the street. As a result, a smooth traffic flow will be ensured without any traffic lights," says Jiří Bodenlos. "I have to warn drivers though: there will be no stopping area in this sector and, should drivers fail to respect the signs, their cars will be towed away."
