New Timetables and a New Shuttle Service Design

The shuttle service, which is in operation on weekdays from 7 am to 7 pm, significantly facilitates personal transport to the complex, making it faster. This system will be further improved as another route is to be launched on 1 November 2011. The new service will be in operation between Budějovická C Metro Station and Olbrachtova Street, running along the route of Želetavská – Brumlovka – and back.
